

Then & Now

July 28, 1943 — President Roosevelt is personally told by a Polish agent that Germany is proceeding to eliminate the Jews from Europe. He tells Roosevelt that he has seen the death camps and the ongoing slaughter of Jews in Europe.

March, 1999 — The Serbs start their offensive to ethnically cleanse Ethnic Albanians from Kosovo. The Serbs previously demonstrated their method of ethnic cleansing in Bosnia, specifically in Srebrenica where they herded 7,000 men and boys to a U.N. Safe Haven and executed them.

July 28, 1943 — President Roosevelt announces that the Allies have to win the war first and then they will come to the aid of the Jews in Europe. This policy continued until the end of the war with the Allies refusing the request of the World Jewish Congress to help Jews escape and refusing to bomb death camps. Four million more Jews die before the Allies win the war and come to the aid of the Jews in Europe.

March/April, 1999 — President Clinton announces: He has no intention of sending in ground troops in Kosovo, he announces a bombing campaign to stop the Serbs, and further states that as soon as this bombing campaign wins the war and drives the Serbs from Kosovo, NATO will come to the aid of the Ethnic Albanians. The Serbs proceed to murder, rape, burn villages and drive over 500,000 Ethnic Albanians from Kosovo.

History records that fifty-six years ago the first voice of the U.S. Government to issue a call for action to save the Jews of Europe from the ongoing genocide was the Foreign Affairs Committee of the U.S. Senate. It passed the following resolution on December 20, 1943:

“We have talked; we have sympathized; we have expressed our horror; the time to act is long past due.”
